This is a very special, urgent request from the Stingrays (Northland Club). Please read

Jimmy Hawes and his wife Aurora have only been in Kerikeri for 2 and a half years, but they have made a big impact on our small inline hockey community. Jimmy became a part of the Stingrays family and travelled with his teammates to the Nationals at the beginning of October – no small feat for a relatively new hockey player.



Only weeks after his return from the Nationals Jimmy and Aurora received some heart-breaking news. Jimmy was diagnosed with Stage 4 Cancer, a tumour in his colon and cancer on 95% of his liver. The outlook is not great but if chemo helps, there are some unfunded treatments that can

they will face. They are both so young (32 and 31), got married in 2021 and where thinking of starting a family.

This is a great opportunity for our clubs to come together, make new friends, and to all be on the same side supporting one of our players.
